



Lester A. (Dude) Fogle, 94, passed away on Friday, March 16, 2007 at Edgewood Vista in Belgrade. He was born on August 12, 1912 in Moore Montana to John Fredrick and Leora Edith (Stratton) Fogle.

As a child Les lived in Moore, Valentine, and Roy Montana as well as Oregon and Washington. He came to Bozeman in 1929, where he resided until his death.

On December 24, 1938 Les married Mary Hoffman in Livingston.

He worked at the Bozeman Pea Cannery during World War II and worked for the Montana State Highway Department as a welder. He also worked at the Rod and Reel Sport Shop on East Main, as a parking lot attendant at First Security Bank and owned the Wallace Street Grocery Store with his wife, Mary.

In his younger years he hunted and fished, called square dances at school dances and at the Eagles Lodge. He was active in the PTA at Hawthorne School in the 1950's. Les was a 66 year member of the fraternal order of Eagles where he served as president of the local lodge twice and was the State President from 1970-1971.
