



L. Byrdie "Bud" Moore, 91, passed away on Friday, April 20, 2007, in Bozeman. Bud was born on November 28, 1915, in Malden, Missouri, to James and Lydia (Gulledge) Moore.

Bud attended rural schools through the eighth grade and then farmed with his father until his enlistment into the Army on September 22, 1942. He spent most of his military service in Seattle, WA, and was honorably discharged in Feb. of 1945.

Bud met his wife, Nell Sue Rampy, in 1944; they were married on September 27, 1944.

Following a short stay in Montana, L.B. and his family returned to Missouri where he was employed by Anderson Air Activities. In 1960, Bud and his family returned to Bozeman where he worked in a lumber mill and as a construction laborer. In 1963, he went to work as a custodian for the Bozeman School District, retiring in December 1980.

After retiring he became a member of the McDonald's "social club" and enjoyed church, singing, and watching the news--politics.

Bud was preceded in death by his parents and four sisters.

He is survived by his wife, Nell of Bozeman; son, Roland (Robin) Moore of Norris, MT; two daughters, Byrdeen (Bill) Warwood of Bozeman and Leanne (Steve) Farina of McCamey, TX; six grandchildren, Roland Moore, Tyffani Buchanan, Molly Moore, Brandon Warwood, Stephan Farina and Ali Farina; one great grandson, William Buchanan; and several nieces and nephews.
