Amy was cancer free for 23 years. In January of 2010, she was diagnosed with Adeno Carcinoma. For this battle, C.J. was at her side for 4 1/2 months until she lost the battle. Battle it was too, as her spirit, faith and fight was unbelievable.

Amy loved working in her garden, or as she called it, "Dirt Therapy". She loved playing cards, scrapbooking, and being a "Domestic Goddess." C.J.'s claim to fame was getting Amy playing goofy computer games. Her favorite was Plants vs. Zombies.
