



**D**uwain L. Miller, 83, of Livingston, died Tuesday morning, June 1, 2010 at Evergreen Livingston Health and Rehab Center. Cremation has taken place. Dokken-Nelson Funeral Service is in charge of arrangements. A memorial service will be held on Saturday, June 5, 2010 at 3:00 p.m. at The Valley Shepherd Church of the Nazarene. Pastor Jack Camp will preside over the service.

Duwain was born July 9, 1926 in Froid, MT to John and Alice (Stratton) Miller, where they lived until Duwain was nine years old. At that time the family, including two younger brothers, moved to the west coast where Duwain resided for most of his life, except for a period of two or three years that he spent in Alaska on a job affiliated with the Alaska pipeline.
