



Susan R. Quayle, 81, passed away July 25, 2007 in Bozeman. She was born April 26, 1926 in Iron River, Michigan, the daughter of Doris and Raymond Tegge.

She graduated from Iron River High School with the class of 1943. She attended Northern Michigan University and subsequently graduated from the Gale Institute of Aeronautics in Minneapolis, and Civil Aeronautics Administration Center in Chicago, respectively.

On December 12, 1947, she married Stephen Edward Quayle in Houston, Texas. They had two sons, Stephen Raymond Quayle and Clayton Randolph Quayle.

She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary, Lily of the Valley Order of Easter Star, and politically active in various official capacities with the Gallatin County Republican Women, having served as president for three terms.
