

Harry John Leonard, 86, of Bozeman, passed away in the early morning hours of November 7, 2007.

He was born near Chetek, Wisconsin on July 10, 1921 to Harry and Genevieve Leonard. Harry enlisted in the U.S. Army in May, 1940 and was stationed in Panama until 1943.
