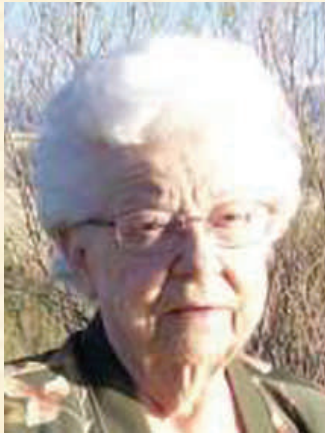


## Edith Doig

August 6, 1922- March 1, 2009



Edith Evon Miller Doig was born August 6, 1922 at Reese Creek, at aunt Clara Warwood's home, to Emil and Araminta Benbrooks Miller, the fifth of six children. She spent her childhood at the Miller homestead on the Middle Fork of Sixteenmile creek, attended school through the eighth grade in a one-room log cabin, and graduated from Belgrade High School in 1940. She was married to Arnold Doig the June after graduation. He died in November of 2006 after 66 years of marriage.

Edith moved to Texas to be with Arnold while he was in the Army Air Corps then to Idaho while Arnold was studying at the College of Idaho, then returned to Montana when Arnold was sent overseas to France.

When Arnold returned to Montana, they started a family and Arnold and Guy Warwood started the Warwood and Doig Chevron station on Mendenhall in Bozeman.

She is survived by her children, Don of Manhattan, Bruce of the Sacramento, California area, and Trudene (Boyd) James of Hyrum, Utah.
